The Parade of Garage Sales on Saturday, May 28th, will let you clean your basements and garages while making a couple of dollars – and the beauty is that you need not worry about advertising: we will take care of that! (you may want to still have signs and balloons to draw attention etc. And...there will be prizes in different categories as judged by one of our own.

The Curbside Free-Cycle from Sunday, May 29th to Saturday June 4th, centers on stuff that you are unable (or didn't dare try!) to sell at your garage sale. As the old saying goes, "one person's junk is another person's treasure." With these items we are suggesting to people to **tastefully and safely** display them in the front or rear of their property. Anyone may come by and pick them up during this time at no cost. After the 4th we are asking you to bring these items down to the dumpster day or store back back inside. (see below items that will not be accepted)



The Community Clean Up / Dumpster Day from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Sunday June 5th completes the series of events with the opportunity to finally dump many unwanted items into one of three large bins provided by the City of Calgary and placed at the **Glendale Community Hall parking lot**. **This service is FREE**, though you will have to get the items to the hall yourself. The Glendale 101 Scouts will be there to be your guides. In addition to the dumpsters, there will be a **home electronic recycling** bin, a **metal recycling** bin, and the **Diabetes Association** will also be available from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM to accept any reasonable reusable items (please remove any garage sale price tags from items - appliances are not accepted).

NOTE: The following items will **not be accepted**: tires, paint, refrigerators or freezers, liquids, and glass. Some suggestions of how to dispose of these safely will be in the our Thumper Newsletter.
